Las Mujeres: Latina Lives, American Dreams (in production) – Producer/Director/Editor. Docu-series examines the lives of Latinas living in the U.S.

Rubi: A DACA Dreamer in Trump's America (2020-2021) – Producer/Director/Editor. NETA distribution to public television stations nationwide. Biographical documentary tells the story of the immigration crisis through the eyes of 22-year-old Rubi, and undocumented DACA Dreamer, graduating college under the Trump presidency.

The Salinas Project (2015) – Producer/Director/Editor. Distribution by American Public Television to public television stations nationwide and multiple World Channel broadcasts. Feature length documentary profiles the children of immigrant Latino farm workers in the East Salinas.

From the Fields: An American Journey (2012/2013) – Producer/Director/Editor. Distribution to NBC affiliate stations nationwide through NBC Network Affiliate Relations. Thirty-minute biographical documentary examines the life of a Damian Trujillo, from farm-worker to journalist.

On the Line (2011) – Producer/Director/Editor. NETA distribution to public television stations nationwide. 30 and 50 minute (two lengths cut) documentary investigates the anti-immigrant/militia movement in Arizona and issues of Latino identity.

Produced seven shorts and 2 multimedia articles related to immigration detention system, migrant experiences crossing the border, life in border communities, and humanitarian organizations working on the border.
